Christopher Ash, our main speaker, is Director of the Cornhill Training Course in London, a one-year training course with the primary aim of training preachers. Prior to that he was pastor of a small rural church in the East of England. He is married to Carolyn with four children, mostly grown up. He is author of several books, including *Married for God*, *Bible Delight*, *Job: Out of the Storm*, *The Priority of Preaching & Listen Up!*

Eddie Coulter is superintendent of the Irish Church Mission in Dublin and an Anglican minister.
